The new keyword in JavaScript can be quite confusing when it is first encountered, as people tend to think that JavaScript is not an object-oriented programming language. What is it? What problems



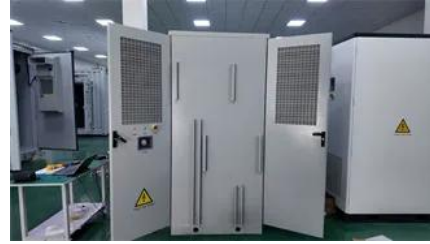
[Is JavaScript's "new" keyword considered harmful?](#)
