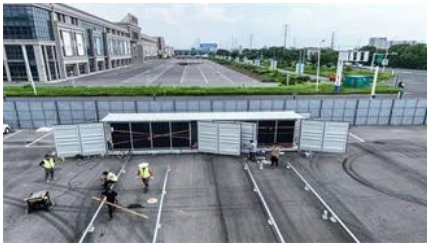


[How does the new operator work in JavaScript?](#)
