Overview

The new operator uses the internal `[[]]` method, and it basically does the following: Initializes a new native object Sets the internal `[[]]` of this object, pointing to the Function prototype

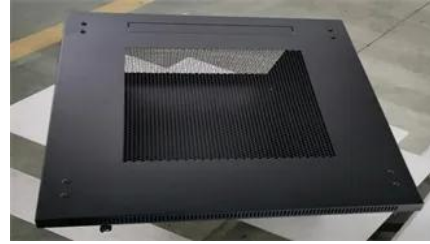
