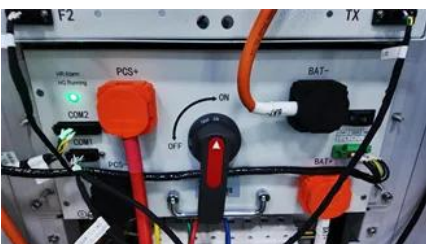

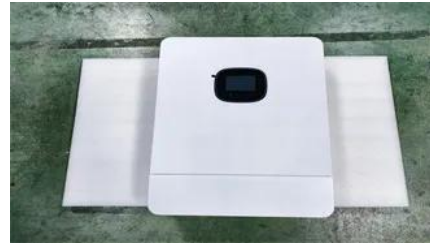


List of Olympic Games host cities
